As you probably know Georgia Beta of Pi Mu Epsilon has replaced the old Mathematics Club which is no longer in existence. The operation of the organization is somewhat different from that of the Mathematics Club, so a different write-up is in order. The sentence in quotes below is from the National constitution of the organization.

"Pi Mu Epsilon is a non-secret organization whose purpose is the promotion of scholarly activity in mathematics among students in academic institutions and among the staffs of qualified non-academic institutions."

Members are elected to Georgia Beta of Pi Mu Epsilon on a basis their proficiency in mathematics as well as on their other scholastic achievements. Membership is not restricted to class; however the membership requirements cannot usually be met before the junior year.

The main program of the organization consists of lectures delivered by members and invited speakers during the school year. The organization also sponsors a series on talks on mathematical topics designed to be of particular interest to freshmen.
